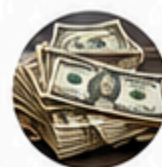

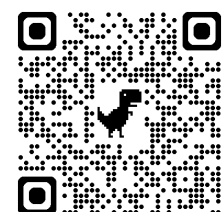
FINAL VERDICT
