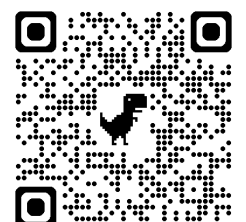
Miami may not offer the museums of Washington, DC, the walkability of Boston, or the value of Chicago.
